





CSIR National Physical Laboratory (NPL), New Delhi

The students of bachelors and masters degree programmes of Chemistry and Physics along with faculty members Dr. Anindita Roy Chowdhury and Dr. Soumita Talukdar visited NPL on their Open Day on 30 September 2019. The group were guided to a section where Traceability of DC Standard was displayed. Calibration of source using accurate resistors and capacitors were illustrated. Accurate resistors and capacitors, imported from USA were shown to them and the high level of their precision was highlighted. Another lab display unit illustrated the flux decay of LED bulb. The other display unit that the students visited was on Status of Calibration of Phasor Measurement Unit System. The students were introduced to the process of standardization of AC parameters by comparing it with DC. AC-DC transfer difference was demonstrated. As manual measurements in this regard are tedious, scholars at NPL have developed LabView Based Automated System for Frequency Counter that was illustrated to the students. The students were taken to the auditorium where they were shown a short film highlighting the research work that go on in the various research laboratories of NPL. year round.

Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary

Dr. Parveen Kumar from School of Basic and Applied Sciences along with Dr. Abul K. Azad, Dr. Arpita Rastogi, Dr. Raveena Negi, and Dr. Anurag Tripathi of School of Agricultural Sciences organized two day field visit related to Environmental Studies for the students of B. Sc. (H) Agriculture (3rd Semester), School of Agriculture Science (SoAS) at Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary, Tughlakabad, New Delhi on 4 and 7 October 2019. A total of 173 students of SoAS participated in the field studies which were conducted under guidance of field experts of Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) and faculty members of GD Goenka University. The visit comprised of visit to Biodiversity Park to study plant and animal diversity, Butterfly garden to study butterflies, its habitat and ecological significance and to trail in nature through Asola Wildlife Sanctuary - to study plants, animals, and insect diversity.

The students also participated in Wildlife Sketching and Nature Photography competitions as part of World Wildlife Week Program organized by Department of Forests and Wildlife, Govt. of NCT of Delhi in association with BNHS on the theme 'Life Below Water' from 2 – 11 October, 2019 at Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary.







All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi (AIIMS)

M.Sc. Forensic Science students along with faculty member, Dr. Neeharika Srivastava went for this educational excursion to Forensic Medicine and Toxicology Department, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) on 22 November 2019. During the visit to the department, students saw various exhibits like biological specimen, arms and ammunitions submitted in the department for analysis. The students further visited laboratories namely toxicology lab and DNA Fingerprinting lab under the supervision of Dr. Jaiswal (Senior Scientist) where they were introduced to different instruments used in analysis. Students received an exposure to the working and applications of instruments like Gas Liquid Chromatography, Head Space Gas Chromatography, HPLC, UV-Vis Spectrophotometer, Biochemical Analyser, Electrophoresis, Gel Doc, Blotting techniques etc. Apart from the laboratory visit, students went to mortuary to witness the post mortem of an unnatural death under the supervision of Dr. Pooja where reason of death was found to be myocardial infraction after performing autopsy.

Acharya Narendra Dev College, University of Delhi

All the B.Sc. and M.Sc. students of the Department of Biological Sciences (Biochemistry and Microbiology) visited Acharya Narendra Dev College (University of Delhi) for getting exposure of basic and applied techniques of biology on 22 November 2019. Students visited four laboratories, namely, Anti-mycobacterial Drug Discovery Laboratory, Microbial Technology Laboratory, Insect-Vector and Pest Laboratory and Ciliate Biology Laboratory. The students had hands-on experience in handling cultures of bacteriophages, ciliates, bacteria and other microbes and basic and advanced molecular techniques like DNA isolation, Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR), Gel Electrophoresis etc.
















Creative Corner

The Value of Dessert

Fitness and Mindfulness

Intensity is the key for results and workout is measured by time and power. The more work you do in less time, the more intense the effort, the better the output.

To put it more clearly, it a high intensity timed workout. Everyday trainer explains the Workout of the day and depending on the workout there is either a cap time, EMOM (every minute on the minute) or AMRAP (as many reps as possible).

What is Mindfulness?

Mindfulness means maintaining a moment-bymoment awareness of our thoughts, feelings, bodily sensations, and surrounding

Combining the two (Cross fit-Mindfulness)

Cross fit is timed workout in which you are given a goal (workout of the day) in the beginning of the class. Also, this workout is very competitive as one has to finish the task and trainer notes down timing of each group member and your performance is compared with other members at the end of the class. When we sit for meditation we think of all possible things that have happened or yet to happen, most of the experts suggest that let your thoughts flow but this workout has helped me to be in the moment along with heightened body awareness and focus.
