

7TH CONVOCATION CEREMONY GD GOENKA UNIVERSITY



t was a momentous day at GD Goenka University as after a pandemic enforced break of two years on all regular academic activities, the day saw the oncampus organization of the 7th Annual Convocation on 14 May 2022. This ceremony, organized in person, was graced by the Hon'ble Governor of Haryana, Shri Bandaru Dattatraya, Mrs. Kala Ramachandran, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, Hon'ble Chancellor of GD Goenka University, Mrs. Renu Goenka, Vice-Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) Tabrez Ahmad, Registrar, Dr. Dhirendra Singh Parihar and Prof. (Dr.) Tanuia Kaushik. Convocation Convener and Dean Student Welfare, Deans/Heads from the different schools of the University as also other dignitaries from the academic world. The Convocation was formally declared open by the Hon'ble Chancellor, Mrs. Renu Goenka and this was



The conferment of her degree was greeted with cultural ululation by the Lesotho contingent.

Dr. Ramakoae greeted the dignitaries present and said she was delighted and humbled to accept this honor, not only on account of her own self, family and country, but in the honor of young people all over the world, raised in circumstances of scarcity. Dr. Ramakoae pointed out to GDGU as a University of great potential and happily acknowledged the presence of students from Lesotho in the University Student Body, some of whom were even present in the audience. She rightly said that the people blessed with opportunities must not waste their opportunities but open the doors for other disadvantaged people to let them in. Dr. Ramakoae pointed out to the historical bonds of the Kingdom of Lesotho and India as partners of non-aligned movement, as members of the U.N. and also for playing a significant role in the fight for freedom. She said that the Kingdom of Lesotho benefits from its co-operation with India in education and health care and looked forward to further collaborations between the two countries. Dr. Ramakoae's expressed her happiness and gratitude in the recognition of her work by the University and reiterated her desire to work further for the disadvantaged. She ended her speech with a remembrance of her late daughter, Mots' Elisi, lost tragically to the pandemic, and with her best wishes for the growth and advancement of



Training Programme

The School in collaboration with College of Agriculture, Agricultural Development Trust, Baramati focuses on developing the student skills, knowledge generation, participation, agricultural innovation, through a training programme for 12 days to get immense hands-on experience and exposure to modern agricultural technology interventions. A total of 59 students participated and they were divided into two batches. The training programme was held from 28 December 2021 - 08 January 2022 and was conducted by Prof. C.V. Shende, Training Coordinator. The programme was graced by Hon'ble, Prof. Nilesh Nalwade, Director, CoA, Baramati, highlighted the key notes related to a successful training programme. The students were exposed to following visits where they experienced hands on training:

FIELD VISITS

IHDC Hodal Visit, Palwal Haryana

On 03 March 2022, our students and faculty members visited IHDC, Hodal. Our students along with the subject expert visited the fully automatic polyhouse. Students learned about different types of polyhouse, nursery preparation, commercial horticulture, fertigation etc. They visited the naturally ventilated polyhouse next, where chilli and tomato crops were raised. Students also learned about fertigation methods and preparation of fertigation solutions. The students also became familiar with drip irrigation and advantages of drip methods for quality production. Students also visited the solar operated cold storage which is of primary importance for storage of fruits and vegetables. Students interacted with subject experts and clarified their doubts regarding high-tech polyhouse cultivation. Overall it was a fruitful and knowledge enhancing experience for students in the area of protected cultivation. A total of 115 students attended the Visit and gained enriched learning.



Exposure Visit to Victory Mushroom Farm Dhansa, Delhi

Victory Mushroom Farm is situated in Dhansa Village of Najafgarh area coming under National Capital Region. It is owned by a progressive farmer Mr. Narender Dagar. A total of 81 students and 6 faculty members visited the farm on 23 February 2022. Mr. Dagar is cultivating three different types of mushrooms i.e. oyster, button and milky mushroom in natural conditions inside specialised bamboo huts made by himself. The students learnt selection of the type of mushroom for cultivation; their care and handling; marketing strategy and also had a hands on demonstration of the oyster mushroom mixture preparation.

Radio Sessions with Raibala Foundation






Notes to NATA, UID Entrance Workshop for Architecture Aspirants

This webinar addressed the need of an alternative assessment technique called Portfolio which is one of the main recommendations of NEP 2020 which calls for a shift from (an assessment system) that is summative and tests more memorization skills to one that is more regular and formative and competence based. She explained how the portfolio assesses what the students can actually do with the English language in their real-life situations. Portfolio is based on an objectivereferenced evaluation that relates a student's performance to instructional objectives in a specific English lesson plan. She elaborately described that the self-reflective element in the portfolio makes it more personalized and enhances the feeling of learner's ownership of their work, allowing students to contribute their own insight about their learning. She also gave some tips and techniques to language teachers on how they can incorporate different activities like role play, interviews, quizzes, tests, assignments, writing tasks, self assessment to each of the items in the portfolio. She concluded the webinar by summarizing how portfolio not only helps in development and assessment of comprehensive language skills learning but also gives them the opportunity to excel in organizational skills, decision making skills, self reflection skills, and critical analysis skills. At the end, a vote of thanks was presented by Dr. Parvesh Lata to Ms. Payal Mittal. Many scholars from different schools of GDGU participated in this webinar and made it a success through their presence.

Appointment of Judges to the Supreme Court & Gender Diversity: A Comparative Study with Reference to India and United States

She spoke on the topic Appointment of Judges to the Supreme Court and Gender Diversity: A Comparative Study with Reference to India and the United States. During her presentation, the speaker questioned whether gender diversity is a criterion for appointment to the Supreme Court and if it is so then how diverse has the Supreme Court been till now. She emphasised that the scope of her study is narrowed by limiting it to the appointments made in the Supreme Court of India and the Supreme Court of United States as the apex court in democratic countries act as watchdogs of the Constitution and contribute as much to the evolution of law as the legislating body of the country. According to the speaker, though Article 124 of the Constitution of India does not provide for reservation and the Constitution of the United States of America too does not prescribe any qualifications, yet the unwritten norms have evolved that has determined the composition of the Courts 16 and several scholars have undertaken to study the factors that has affected the composition of the courts. The seminar was presided over by Prof. (Dr.) Tabrez Ahmad and moderated by Dr. Priti Ramani Nayyar, Asst. Professor and Ph.D. Program Leader, SOL. Amongst the audience faculty members, research scholars and practicing advocates were present, who all found the seminar very insightful and informative.



Digitalizing Extension Services

Digitalization is the most potent feature in today's era spreading wildly across all aspects of this world. Agriculture is one of the only sectors that is yet to reap benefits of digital services. Through transfer of systems from 'Text to Tech', the digitalization of extension services ensures that people will get equal opportunities to gain technical knowledge regardless of their size of holding, societal class and caste differences. Due to ease of access to digital services, a massive outspread of new technology from the 'lab to land' will be able to cater to around 267 million farmers PAN India. Embracing digital systems will establish a revolutionary open platform providing farmers an interface to access information and the ability to interact with subject matter specialists, buyers, vendors etc. directly without a middleman. Dissemination of knowledge, technology, guidance and resources will improve people's standard of living, therefore, increasing the country's national and per capita income. Enhancement of already compelling strategies through digital extension services will expand the agriculture and allied sectors exponentially, greatly influencing the urban, rural and remote areas.

Currently, over 190 million of the Indian population is malnourished, 65% of reservoirs are below normal water level and 12% are dry and the use of excess urea by some farmers is deteriorating our 394.6 million acres of arable land. With about 70% of our farmers being small and marginal landholders, they lack technical knowledge about credit facilities, crop benefit schemes, amenities, soil and water management techniques, and so on. Owing to their lack of knowledge and facilities, not only are huge amounts of losses incurred by the farmers, lack of judicious use of our raw materials and land is depleting our natural resources at a concerning rate. Countries like Israel adopted ICT extension service in 2008 and it has shown a great increase in their land productivity. Not only do the farmers use techniques like micro-irrigation to conserve soil and water but their nutritional edible food production is 3 times as compared to India despite India's arable land being 517 times as compared to Israel. As of now, only 52.5% of our Indian farmers have a medium level of knowledge about ICTs. Digitalization of extension services will help spread awareness about sustainable agriculture, financial services, innovation systems, food safety, disaster management, market systems etc. necessary for economic development. Computerized services like e-NAM, Kisan call center, Kisan Sarathi have received a great amount of support but it is not enough, awareness of such services must be increased, and platforms like Kisan beej bhandar, farmer markets, and KVKs must help in informing people about such services so that India can prosper in the field of agriculture and allied sectors.

Digitalization is the need of the hour for developing countries hence attention towards generating awareness about it must be prioritized to achieve economic growth, sustainable development and prosperity.



Hello readers!!! I,Priya Pandit and Shrusti Salini Sahoo (friends and batchmates) from BA LLB IInd Year are penning our internship experience which we did together during the month of February, 2022. For many students, including us, internships are a vital way to learn and gain experience outside of the classroom in the fields they're studying. This semester, we interned at the office of Senior Advocate of Supreme Court, Mr. Pradeep Rai. He is also the chairman of Indian Legal Aid Centre and the Vice president of the Bar Association of the Supreme Court. Here we worked as legal interns for a whole month. This was an online internship programme.

Our internship started with LinkedIn. Being a IInd Year law student we already had our profiles on LinkedIn. During this whole time, we continued to send our CVs to the well-known law offices and firms through LinkedIn via mail. We mainly aimed for the Senior Advocate's Office and this is how we got our CV approved by Mr. Pradeep Rai's Office. After getting on board, we had an introductory session where we were explained how to proceed with the work and what the learning outcomes were. So in the first whole week we were asked to prepare case notes on current criminal and civil matters by checking case lists from the official Supreme Court and High Court website followed by drafting in later weeks. So, here comes the real task. We used to summarise the whole case into 200-300 words. It was initially guite challenging since the pdfs of cases involved a minimum of 60-80 pages and sometimes it could exceed more. But gradually we got the hang of it and it seemed a task which was no more arduous to us. And from the second week onwards, the drafting of the cases began. We used to sit from 9am in the morning to 12 pm in the afternoon to draft the reports on our respective cases. It was a huge task for us to do our assigned work perfectly so that we can stand out from the others. But we never backed out from such a challenge. Being in the virtual mode of internship we still learned a lot and found advantages to working remotely. We were able to focus on the digital aspects of our work with fewer distractions, and now we have become more effective communicators during non-visual interactions. We used to word our questions carefully and thought about how they would be perceived before we ask them.

Thinking about working in a traditional office environment to working remotely wasn't easy, but we were able to solve the problems and adapt along the way. Soon, this new type of work setting started to feel abundantly more natural to us. And we completed our one-month internship with flying colours.
