#### Category of Scholars

Scholars can be registered on full time or on part time basis

- A full time scholar has to attend the University regularly and will be subject to the prescribed attendance rules of the University.
- Professionally employed personnel may be allowed to pursue PhD on part time basis. Such candidates are required to submit a "No Objection Certificate" from their parent organization/department/employer stating that he/she is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis and that his/her duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for research. Part time scholars will have to attend the classes for assigned course-work as per the rules of the University/UGC.

# Candidates are required to bring the original and attested copies of the following documents.

- Photo ID Card (Issued by Government Agency)
- 10th 12th Mark sheets & Certificates
- Graduation Mark sheets & Degree / Provisional Certificate
- Post-Graduation Mark sheets & Degree / Provisional Certificate
- Four copies of recent passport size photographs
- Any other document supporting prior research work undertaken, if any.

#### Minimum Qualifications for Admission

- The minimum qualification required for admission to a PhD Programme is a Master's Degree in the relevant field with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade and Bachelor's Degree (4 years) with a minimum of 75% marks or equivalent grade. Relaxation of 5% of marks from 55% to 50% maybe allowed to SC/ST/OBC/differently abled candidates.
- Additional Minimum qualifications as per University's PhD Regulations Version 7.0
- An Equivalence Committee will be constituted by the Vice Chancellor of GDGU to consider applications other than covered under section (a) who may propose other qualifications/requirements in specific areas, consistent with the norms of the statutory bodies, to the University Research & Innovation Council (URIC) for its recommendation to the Academic Council for approval.
- If considered necessary, DRC may propose other qualifications/requirements in specific areas, consistent with the norms of the statutory bodies, to the URIC for its recommendation to the Academic Council for approval.

### Eligibility Conditions for Admission

- It is desirable that eligible applicant who possess minimum prescribed qualifications for admission to the PhD Programme, have excellent academic/professional track record in the relevant discipline.
  The applicant for part-time PhD should:
- prove to the satisfaction of DRC that his/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time to research.
- ensure that facilities for pursuing research are available at his/her place of work in the chosen field of research, where required.





#### Additional information

#### Minimum Time Period:

• The minimum period for submission of PhD thesis is 3 years from the date of registration. Maximum Period:

• The maximum period for submission of PhD thesis is 6 years from the date of registration. Thereafter, the registration shall stand cancelled automatically unless, for valid reasons, the President of GDGU grants an extension.
