**GD Goenka University Journal of Perspectives in Social Science and Humanities Research** invites scholars, academicians and researchers to submit their unpublished original work for inclusion in the launch issue of the Journal. The original research papers/articles are invited in the areas of economics, environment, political science, psychology, sociology, literature, linguistics, politics, philosophy, history, geography, inter alia. Submissions should be suitable for publication in one of the following sections: Research Papers (5,000-8,000 words), Short Articles (2000-3000 words), Case Studies (3,000-5,000 words), Book Review (1000 – 2000 words), and Unpublished Dissertations (8000 – 100000 words).

To maintain high quality of standard, the menu scripts are subjected to rigorous peer review process. The manuscripts must follow APA style of formatting (12 font size, 1.5 line space).

The authors must submit the declaration for original contribution and non-plagiarism.

The editorial board reserves the right to accept/reject any manuscript.

If manuscript is accepted, the author would be required to transfer the sole and exclusive rights of their paper to the journal, Perspectives in Social Science and Humanities Research. **Please submit your manuscript to managing editor at [psshr.sohss@gdgu.org](mailto:psshr.sohss@gdgu.org) on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023.**

**Guidelines for Submission to the Journal:** All manuscripts should be articulated in the following form:

1. Submission for publication should be in **one file** containing cover page (Page 1), Abstract and Keywords (Page 2), and manuscript (Page 3 onwards).

- a. Cover Page: The cover page must include the title of the paper, name of author(s), affiliation, short bio (not more than 60 words), e-mail address, and contact number.
  - b. Abstract and key-words: The abstract should be concise and factual with maximum **250 words**. It should state briefly the aim, methodology and findings of the study. Abstract must be followed by at least 3-6 keywords.
  - c. Manuscript must include introduction, objectives, research methodology, finding, discussion and analysis, conclusion, suggestion/recommendation and references.
2. **Length** (word limit) for submissions: Research papers - 3000 to 5000 words; Short articles – 2000 to 3500 words; Case Studies – 2500-5000 words; Book reviews - 1000 and 1500 words; Unpublished Dissertations – 7000- 8000 words.
  3. Shorter or longer submissions may be published depending on their strengths. **3. Font** should be in **Times New Roman** with **size 12**.
  4. All submissions must be in **Microsoft Word** and one and a half spaced, not exceed 10 pages in all, A4 size pages.
  5. **American Psychological Association** (APA) 7<sup>th</sup> Ed. style should be followed for in text citations and references.
  6. Pictures, graphs, should be in the highest quality.
  7. Figures/ Charts and tables created in MS word should be included in the main text.
  8. The page numbers should at center of every page.
  9. All headings and sub-headings must be bold – faced, aligned left and in sentence case only.
