





Field Day on Conservation Agriculture Practices



Among maize-based systems, the maize-mustard cropping system is important, productive and highly resilient under different climatic conditions. However, conventional practices have several restraints. mainly due to poor crop establishment and inputs management leading to low productivity and resource use-efficiency. In this context, CA-based maize rotation is being advocated as an alternative to conventional practices. The conservation agriculture concept evolved in a response to the concerns of agricultural sustainability. Which is based on three fundamental interlinked principles; (i) minimal mechanical soil disturbance, (ii) permanent soil cover and (iii) crop diversification. The venue for the event was Instructional farm, GD Goenka University where 2nd and 3rd year students and faculty members under the instruction of Dr Nirai Biswakarma, Dr Ravendranath and Dr Deepayan Roy sowed mustard on 22 September 2022. The objectives of the field day were to adopt and apply principles and practices of conservation agriculture at the field level. It also familiarized the students with recent sustainable management options and the tools/implements used in conservation agriculture practices while widening the understanding of students about the impact of conservation agriculture practices on productivity and the maintenance of soil health. The event also gave the students an opportunity for future research areas after completion of graduation. The event aimed at analyzing the underlying issue of conventional practices in the maize-mustard cropping system. 

The objective of the Presentation Series was to equip Doctorate scholars in honing their knowledge, communication skills along with presentation skills as the department envisions scholars to present their body of work on bigger academic and intellectual platforms in future. This training facilitated their learning and will help them prepare for such platforms. The study aimed to assess the humanitarian crisis created because of the activities of the Boko Haram insurgency in Yobe State, Nigeria. The study was an exploratory type of research. The research findings on the affected areas in Yobe State was that it was an inadequate humanitarian response to people affected by the violence perpetrated by the Boko Haram insurgents. Recommendations of collaborations and people- centred alleviation programs and free education were discussed.

The School of Engineering & Sciences organised a Departmental Seminar Series on 28 July 2022. Ms. Vinita, a research scholar in Mathematics, delivered a talk on A Mathematical Modelling of Magnetohydrodynamic Nanofluid Flow Induced by Three-Dimensional Stretching Surface'. She highlighted various applications in different domains of manufacturing, industry and medicine. The scholar discussed her approach of dealing with various mathematical tools to infer significant analysis about various physical parameters significant for nanofluid flow and specific three-dimensional surface.



Consultancy Project

The School of Humanities Social Sciences & Education has been commissioned for a desk-research consultancy to do Child Rights Situational Analysis Study in India by SOS Children Villages of India (SOSCVI), a pioneering non-profit organization with 56 years of committed experience of caring for parentless & disadvantaged children. The school will be represented by Dr. Imran Amin, Lead Consultant, Associate Professor, and Dr. Rimple Manchanda, Consultant Data Management, Associate Professor, and SOSCVI will be represented by Mr. Sumanta Kar, CEO. The situational analysis builds on secondary sources and data to build a child vulnerability index and map vulnerable children across India. The Consultancy project is from 23 December 2022 till 31 March 2023 and has a total budget Rupees Four Lakh and Twenty-Five Thousand.




