8th edition Annual Convocation

D Goenka University, recognized by the UGC, and a member of prestigious institutions like the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), the Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU) and the International Association of Universities (IAU), organized the 8th edition of its Annual Convocation on 13 May 2023. The Convocation was a grand affair and saw 1109 graduands being awarded, out of which 727 were graduates, 280 postgraduates, 54 Diploma, and 48 Ph.D. degrees in various disciplines The event also had a total of 71 awardees for the prestigious Gopi Ram Goenka medals which included 26 Gold Medallists, 38 silver medallists and 7 bronze medallists. The highlight of the day was the conferment of Honoris Causa on legal luminary Dr. Lalit Bhasin, President, Society of Indian Law Firms and celebrity chef Mr. Ranyeer Singh Brar, who has brought Indian cuisine on the world platform with his passion and expertise. The event saw the presence of the Hon'ble Governor of Haryana, Shri Bandaru Dattatraya, senior management from GD Goenka Group gracing the occasion which included Hon'ble Chancellor Smt. 






# Martyr's Day





Dr. Sachdev highlighted adapting to rapid tech advances, Mr. Leipins and Mr. Chandekar gave examples of how new media like short videos have made storytelling more interactive. Dr. Srinivasan emphasised balancing tech with human-centric design, Mr. Kurungati reflected on evolving sensibilities influencing photography and narratives today. The panel deliberated on trends like digital content creation, designing for shareability, and understanding changing consumer needs. The diverse perspectives offered comprehensive insights on crafting compelling visual stories and making strategic creative choices in a dynamic digital era.

The visit enabled students to appreciate and engage with the thriving Indian and South Asian art landscape.



#### Visit to Surajkund Mela

Our foundation students visited the iconic Surajkund Mela on 8 February 2023 to gain exposure to the rich diversity of Indian and international crafts. By interacting with craftspeople from different states and countries at the fair, the students obtained insights into regional craft techniques, materials and styles. The visit provided an understanding of the efforts behind handmade products and the challenges faced by craft communities. Students had engaging discussions with artisans to learn about their lifestyle, aspirations and concerns. The trip enabled students to appreciate the cultural heritage embodied in traditional crafts and connect it to modern design. #### Talk on Empowering Rural Communities through Self Help Groups

The symphony of life created by the fragrance of soil, the rhythm of air, and the flow of water inspires a sense of spiritual awareness and reminds us of our interconnectedness with all living beings and the environment. The installation was initially set up on campus, and a second version was then installed at the Goenka chowk in Guruaram.





#### **Photography Workshop**

Acclaimed photographer Mr. Srinivas Kuruganti recently conducted a visual appreciation workshop for 1st year design students from 11 April to 12 April 2023. Mr. Kurungati, based in Delhi, has over three decades of experience capturing diverse subjects and themes in India, America and Europe. They went around the campus collecting waste materials like used bottles, broken objects, caps and so on. After gathering the discarded items, students channelized their creativity to transform trash into artworks. Working in teams, they used the junk to make sculptures, installations and models. The creations conveyed messages around waste management and sustainability. The activity was not just fun and engaging, but enabled students to think unconventionally, work collaboratively and turn waste into aesthetic and meaningful creations. The event culminated in an open exhibition of the student's creations.

#### **Disruptive Fashion**

The senior fashion design students were involved in an upcycling workshop using discarded denim where they were challenged to create a range of dresses, skirts, jackets and other garments purely from old jeans, jackets and denim scraps. The workshop was held from 6 March 2023 to 10 March 2023. Students got hands-on experience in creatively transforming denim waste into unique fashionable ensembles. They learned upcycling techniques like stitching, patching, fringing, embroidery and dyeing to reimagine denim items beyond their original construct. The workshop enabled them to innovate zero-waste design solutions aligned with the principles of sustainability. By working with denim waste, students gained valuable skills in reconstruction, reinventing fabrics and building a collection through sustainable practices.
